<b>Prosecco Di Conegliano-Valdobbiadene, Bernardi, Veneto, Italy</b>	36
Clean, fresh and elegant with delicate bubbles that enhance its subtle citrusy fruit and touch of marzipan, dangerously drinkable!	
<b>Tradicional Extra Brut, Colet Vins, Penedes, Spain</b>	38
Elegant and balanced. Aromas of white flowers & some citrus notes. A creaminess on the palette from time spent on the lees. Its lovely balance between rich & refreshing makes it incredibly food friendly but also a great aperitif.	
<b>Devaux Grande Reserve NV, Bar-sur-Seine, France</b>	58.5
Superb value and superb boutique Champagne. Well rounded and balanced palate filled with creamy fruit and lively, lingering finish.	
<b>Ruinart Blanc de Blancs NV, Ruinart, Champagne, France</b>	94
A blend of 100% Premier Cru Chardonnay from the best of recent vintages. A nose of brioche, French toast and roasted almonds & on the palate the wine is very supple and harmonious, with notes of honey and minerals on the long finish. The definition of finesse.	
<b>La Rosita Brut NV, Lobban, Barcelona, Spain</b>	40
Delicious sparkling rosé by a Scottish female winemaker in Spain! Predominantly Grenache & made in the traditional champagne method. Strawberries & cream with nougaty complexity.	
<b>Devaux Grande Reserve Rose NV, Bar-sur-Seine, France</b>	68
A decadent & delicious wine with very fine bubbles, a creamy mouth-feel, raspberries, strawberries & hints of hazelnut.	

# White

- Bergerie de la Bastide Blanc 2018, Southern France** 22  
Discreet and elegant on the nose, it reveals typical notes of dried herbs, white flowers with a touch of lemon. The palate is bright with a lovely and fresh citrusy bite.
- Gran Cerdo Blanco 2018, Gonzalo Grijalba, Rioja, Spain – Vegan** 23  
Beyond the Viura base of this wine, varieties like Sauvignon Blanc and Muscat add some delicious fragrant nuances. A little funky, fresh and fruity natural wine.
- Garganega ‘Torre del Falasco’ 2018, Cantina Valpantena, Veneto, Italy** 24  
Late picked grapes give this spicy juicy little white considerable depth & nuance at a great price.
- Trebbiano D'Abruzzo 2018, Gran Sasso, Abruzzo, Italy** 26  
A fresh and zesty Trebbiano with aromas of fresh apple & pear fruit. The palate is fresh & clean; the pear fruit with balancing apple acidity & persistent length.
- Vermentino 2018, Domaine les Yeuses, Languedoc – Roussillon, France** 27  
Fragrant lemon and apricot, with undertones of Mediterranean herbs. Full of flavour & character with the fresh acidity typical of the variety. A very sophisticated wine at its price level.
- Vinho Verde 2018, Belenus, Vinho Verde, Portugal** 27.5  
This is the perfect sunny afternoon aperitif. Made from handpicked local grapes Loureiro & Pedernã, it is light with refreshing acidity & a slight spritz. Surprising depth & roundness. Extremely drinkable!
- Picpoul de Pinet 2018, Château de la Mirande, Languedoc, France** 28  
Often referred to as the ‘Muscadet of the South’, with its minerality & almost saltiness on the nose from its close proximity to the sea. Surprising complex white with flavours of pears & citrus fruit & fennel, and a zesty finish.
- Furmint 2016, Tornai Somlo, Hungary** 28.5  
A rich and complex wine, very ripe stone fruit & mineral aromas with notes of chamomile and light spice. The palate is rich and textured almost sweet with amazing acidity that gives it balance & a dry finish. Beautiful length. Amazing value!
- Reserve De Gassac Blanc 2017, Mas de Daumas Gassac, Roussillon, France – Organic** 29  
This blend of Viognier and Marsanne from a world famous estate has an attractive nose of ripe pears, apple-blossom and honey. Fleishy fruit on the palate and a surprisingly fresh grapefruit finish.
- Godello Do Monterrei 2017, Mara Martin, Galicia, Spain** 29.5  
From one of the most influential producers in Galicia, this delicious and unusual wine from the Godello grape is bone dry with notes of apple & pear with a citrus tang on the finish.
- Grüner Veltliner 2018, Huber, Austria - Vegan** 30  
Aromas of ripe, juicy pear and white peach with aromatic spice, and a mouth wateringly fresh touch. Powerful yet elegant, pure and finely balanced with a mineral acidity and hints of white pepper.
- Gran Passione Bianco 2017, IGT, Veneto, Italy** 30.5  
A blend of Garganega & Pinot Bianco, much like this vineyards Rosso the white is a truly gorgeous wine. With a lovely floral bouquet and hints of vanilla on the nose; you won't be let down with the palate. It is dry, crisp and fresh, with ripe fruit flavours which balance out the acidity perfectly.
- Chardonnay/Rebula 2018, Gasper, Goriška Brda, Slovenia** 31  
A lovely fresh & fruit driven wine displaying hints of peach and citrus. A vibrant acidity and lovely roundness, from 5% of the wine being fermented in oak, combine on the palate in this compelling Slovenian blend.
- Cora 2018, Loxarel, Penedès, Spain – Biodynamic, Vegan** 31.5  
In Greek mythology Cora means a young & virgin maiden – a perfect name for this delicate & elegant wine. A blend of Muscat d'Alexandria & Xarel.lo it has a nose evoking honeysuckle, white flowers tropical fruit & peach. Fresh & silky on the palate with a lingering finish.
- Verdicchio ‘Costa Verde’ 2018, Tavignana, Marche, Italy - Organic** 32  
White peach and floral notes on the nose continuing onto the palate with citrus & stone fruit, finishing with hints of bitter almond.
- Petit Bourgeois Sauvignon 2018, Henri Bourgeois, Loire, France** 32.5  
Flower and fruit fragrances: elderflower, gooseberry & green notes of peppers & pea shoots, very crisp fruit but with good weight. The dimensions of a good Sancerre.
- Viognier 2018, Maison Les Alexandrins, Northern Rhone, France** 33  
When the heavyweights like Nicolas Jaboulet and Marc Perrin (Chateau de Beaucastel) meet, the outcome can only be one – fireworks. Aromatic yet fresh crisp and mineral with a lovely bright finish.

<b>Tocai Friulano 'Toh' 2018, Di Leonardo, Friuli Venezia, Italy</b>	<b>34</b>
A gentle and approachable style of Friulano, soft, round and mouth filling. Ripe stone & exotic fruits with hints of spice and almond, a clean balancing mineral acidity and lovely length. A wonderful match with charcuterie or richer fish dishes. An alternative to Chardonnay albeit a little drier with a fresher finish	
<b>Pinot Grigio 2018, Istria, Croatia</b>	<b>34.5</b>
Very perfumed with a good core of apple fruit. Lots of character here and certainly more exciting than many Italian versions at the same price.	
<b>Les Pierrières 1er Cotes de Blaye 2017, Château Beaumont, Bordeaux, France</b>	<b>35</b>
Wonderfully ripe elderflower & bell pepper with gently soothing subtle oak. My tasting note says 'yes, please!'	
<b>Hobby, Antão Vaz, 2016, Alentejo, Portugal</b>	<b>35.5</b>
100% Antão Vaz, a lovely wine from this hot new region has a rich & complex character from its 4 months in French oak and its wet stone minerality is reminiscent of a fine Chablis.	
<b>Fiano di Avellino 2017, Lapilli, Campania, Italy</b>	<b>36</b>
A lovely golden yellow colour in the glass leads onto complex aromas of spice, apricot, orange peel, acacia and honey. Good levels of acidity keep the palate fresh and clean.	
<b>Langhe Bianco 'Dragon' 2017, Luigi Baudana, Piedmont, Italy</b>	<b>39</b>
Dry floral and grassy perfumes are supported by distinct mineral notes and a savoury, lifted character on the palate. Chardonnay & Sauvignon with touches of Riesling and Nascetta giving extra elegance & a long refreshing finish.	
<b>Bourgogne Aligote 2017, Goisot, Cotes d'Auxerre, Burgundy, France</b>	<b>40</b>
Benchmark of the 'other' white grape variety of Burgundy; green-gold, ripe yet racy with a lovely acidity to match.	
<b>Riesling 'Tres Naris' 2016, Axel Pauly, Mosel, Germany</b>	<b>41</b>
Now this is interesting. Bone-dry Riesling from a young dynamic producer. Apples & pears with lip smacking verve..	
<b>Albariño 2018, Zarate, Rias Baixas, Spain - Biodynamic</b>	<b>45</b>
Albariño as it should be from one of the best producers in Rias Baixas. Minerality and balance in a bottle, very focused and tight, like a good Chablis. Hidden amongst the steely character of the wine, stone fruits such as peach and apricot lurk– totally delicious!	
<b>Terlaner Classico 2018, Cantina Terlano, Alto Adige, Italy</b>	<b>47</b>
Elegant & harmonious. Ripe tropical flavours, soft white fruit and lovely floral notes with balancing (classic Terlano) mineral acidity. The wine has a long persistent finish.	
<b>Brolettino 2016, Cà dei Frati, Lugana, Lombardy, Italy</b>	<b>52</b>
One of the best Lugas out there. Oak, creamy stone fruit and minerality all balanced in a perfect harmony.	
<b>Sancerre 2018, Domaine Vincente Delaporte, Loire, France</b>	<b>56</b>
A full flavoured Sancerre from classic 'silex' soils, a perfect balance of fruit, finesse, aromatic complexity and minerality. Great purity of fruit and perfectly balanced acidity; a fine wine	
<b>Macon Villages 'Les Sardines' 2017, Domaine Robert Denogent, Burgundy, France</b>	<b>61</b>
Aromas of red apple intertwined with toasty oak and brioche. The palate is precise with superb definition and intensity. It has racy acidity and a long finish.	
<b>'Vie di Romans' Chardonnay 2017, Vie di Romans, Isonzo, Friuli, Italy</b>	<b>62</b>
This Chardonnay made from single vineyard, hand selected grapes is stunning. The oak integrates perfectly with the fruit & it has a length of flavour & complexity that is seldom found outside of Burgundy.	
<b>Condrieu 2016, Pierre Gaillard, Rhone, France</b>	<b>72</b>
A beautiful & classic wine from a much respected wine maker. Lovely perfumes of honeysuckle, lychee & white peaches. Seven to eight months in oak barriques develop its complex aromas & elegantly soft palate.

<b>Sola Fred 2017, Celler Maisroig, Monstant, Spain</b>	<b>30</b>
A savoury Mediterranean style rosé with aromas of soft red fruits & bags of vibrant acidity. Perfect sunny afternoon tippie	
<b>Côtes De Provence 'Cuvée Elegance' 2018, Carteron, Provence, France</b>	<b>32</b>
Prettily fragrant with a bouquet of red berry fruits & sweet jasmine. Dry, elegant, shimmering acidity and vibrant summer fruits, with a brush-stroke of Chablis-like minerality.	
<b>TM Rosé 2018, Monteti, Tuscany, Italy</b>	<b>46</b>
This blend of 80% Merlot & 20% Cabernet Franc from our favourite super Tuscan producer is surprisingly delicate with a lovely pale colour & a nose of white peach & red berries. Dry, elegant & shimmering acidity. A sophisticated 'aperitivo'

<b>Bergerie de la Bastide Rouge 2018, Languedoc</b>	22
Ruby red with red fruit aromas of cranberries and red cherries it is light, clean and fresh on the palate with lively acidity and recurrent flavours of cassis and vanilla.	
<b>Pinot Nero 2018, Ca' di Alte, Veneto, Italy</b>	24
This attractive pinot puts many a Bourgogne rouge to shame with its lovely perfume of wild cherries & spice. On the palate juicy cherries & strawberries. Good length & a well-balanced bargain!	
<b>Chaval, Bobal Ecologica, Bodegas Nodus, Valencia, Spain - Organic</b>	25
This deliciously spicy, deep-fruited wine is made organically with lots of dark fruit, clove spices and gently grippy structure - All in all a hugely satisfying drink that won't break the bank or harm the planet!	
<b>Rosso Piceno "Bacchus" 2018, Ciu Ciu, Marche, Italy – Organic, Vegan</b>	26
A juicy wine, bursting with flavours of red cherries, bright raspberries, strawberries and liquorice! Uncomplicated but beautifully crafted.	
<b>Cerejeiras 2017, Lisbon, Portugal</b>	26.5
A bouquet of red fruits with a slightly floral edge. Full and well balanced palate laden with damson & cherries.	
<b>Cariñena 3C 2017, Grandes Vinos y Viñedos, Cariñena, Spain</b>	27
Cariñena is both an appellation and a grape variety. The 3C is fresh, unoaked and packed with Carignan goodness. Soft tannins and overflowing and intense with characteristic raspberry. Perfect pizza pairing	
<b>Malbec 'Exception' 2017, Gaudou, Cahors, France</b>	28
A French Malbec from the region around Cahors, not fat and punchy as you know it from Argentina, but Malbec in its most pure, fruity and elegant form - succulent, bright & smooth. Very user friendly.	
<b>Primitivo 'I Muri' 2018, Vigneti del Salento, Puglia, Italy</b>	28.5
Classic style Primitivo, an abundance of dark plums, blackberries & blueberries, soft tannins & a touch of liquorice & violets. A serious crowd pleaser & great value from the Southern tip of Italy.	
<b>Herdade Penedo Gordo DOC 2018, Alentejo, Portugal</b>	29
Concentrated and well textured (due to short oak ageing) wine that keeps the freshness. Red fruits & spices.	
<b>Beaujolais-Villages, 2017, Dominique Morel, Beaujolais, France</b>	31
Clear ruby in the glass with delicate cherry perfumes. The rounded palate is full of fresh red berry fruit. Elegant, well balanced with good acidity, this is a great example of Beaujolais-Villages.	
<b>Garnacha 2017, Viña Zorzal, Navarra, Spain</b>	32
This 100% Garnacha from Navarra delivers bags of lively and juicy strawberries. It has medium weight, very soft tannins and lots of freshness. Excellent with barbeques or spicy food.	
<b>Côtes du Rhône 2017, Domaine Chapoton, Rhone</b>	33
Crunchy vibrant dark fruit, delicious spicy savoury notes & powerful but not heavy finish.	
<b>Gran Passione Rosso 2017, IGT, Veneto, Italy</b>	34
A blend of Corvina & Merlot, much like an Amarone, the grapes are laid out to dry before squeezing to intensify the flavour. Vibrant purple in colour, rich luscious nose full of sweet ripe dark cherry, plum, vanilla and spice. Rich and velvety, with lots of juicy fruit. Very easy drinking.	
<b>Spätburgunder 2016, Weingut Petri, Pfalz, Germany</b>	34.5
An elegant style of Pinot Noir with beautiful perfumed aromas of raspberry & strawberry with underlying savoury, vegetal notes with spice & a light creaminess.	
<b>Chianti Colli Senesi DOCG 2017, Salcheto, Tuscany, Italy - Organic</b>	35
An easy drinking everyday wine, part matured in American Oak to promote soft & elegant notes. Classic cherries & spice, served in the lightest & most ecological bottle on the market.	
<b>Bourgueil 'Diptyque' 2017, Domaine de la Chevalerie, Loire, France - Organic</b>	35.5
This 100% Cabernet Franc is delightful ! Fresh, yet intense, with a floral bouquet and flavours of raspberry and blackberry. Its lovely rounded palate has a nice bite from firm tannins. Perfect with charcuterie and aged cheeses.	
<b>Bierzo 2018, Castro Ventosa Joven, Bierzo, Spain</b>	36
This 100% Mencía offers stunning value for money from the up-and-coming Bierzo region in northwest Spain. It is very fruit-forward but with some mineral and meaty undertones. The attack is crunchy and grippy yet it finishes dry and clean.	
<b>Wien 2 2018, Roman Pfaffl, Weinviertel, Austria</b>	36.5
A delicious blend of Austria's native Zweigelt & Pinot Noir that could be mistaken for a baby Burgundy. A smoky nose with red berry fruits and spicy notes with a soft fleshy palate showing spice, red & black fruits with hints of the forest floor. A long-time favourite of ours.	
<b>Rioja Reserva 2014, Izadi, Rioja, Spain</b>	37
Shiny ruby red in colour. Rich aromatic intensity and a nice balance of red fruit, liquorice and spices, with hints of smoke in the background. Elegant and round on the palate with a long aftertaste full of floral and ripe fruit note	

<b>Blaufränkisch Horitschoner 2016, Weinut Franz Weninger, Austria - Biodynamic</b>	<b>38</b>
A biodynamic Blaufränkisch, aged in used oak barrels, delivering a refined blend of cherry fruits & blackberries. Soft tannins and a lasting finish. Exceptional quality at this price point if you are looking to try something different!	
<b>El Gordito 2013, Lobban Wines, Jumilla, Spain</b>	<b>39</b>
We are a big fan of Pamela Geddes, who also makes our Rosita Brut. This Monastell Shiraz blend has a very savoury backbone to this wine with black berry fruit, spice, toast & ripe tannins. Dangerously drinkable.	
<b>Recantina 2017, Serafini &amp; Vidotto, Veneto, Italy</b>	<b>40</b>
Francesco Serafini brought this grape back from near extinction & it is gaining somewhat of a following. Perfumed dark blueberry & plum fruits combine with spice & earth and gamey hints. The palate is almost chocolatey, lots going on here. The finish is fresh & powerful with lovely balance making you reach for another glass!!	
<b>Rosso di Montefalco 2014, Adanti, Umbria, Italy</b>	<b>41</b>
A traditional old school Sangiovese dominated wine, warm and attractive aromas that combine dark cherry and plum fruits, earthiness, spiciness and dried herbs. The palate is mid to full bodied yet provides a silky seamless texture, powerful, warm and inviting with firm structure and great persistence.	
<b>Dolcetto d'Alba 2018, Aldo Vajra, Piedmont, Italy</b>	<b>42</b>
Always so good; perfumed & textured in that soft delicious plump Dolcetto way - blueberry fruit & the rest.	
<b>Xinomavro 2012, Markovitis Winery, Naoussa, Greece - Organic</b>	<b>43</b>
This fabulous little Greek number is from a small producer famous for his 100% Xinomavro wines. An aromatic variety with good tannic structure often likened at this level to fine Burgundian Pinot or Barolo.	
<b>Rosso Di Montepulciano 2017, Cantine Dei, Tuscany, Italy</b>	<b>44</b>
Pure, elegant and so bright and vibrant. Spicy with glossy black fruit and some red notes of cooked cherry, this is cracking stuff.	
<b>Barbera 'Sant' Andrea' 2018, Vigne Marina Coppi, Colli Tortonesi, Piedmont, Italy</b>	<b>45</b>
Utterly the grandest charming family find in recent years. Hand nurtured vines & always a lovely plump ripe wine.	
<b>Bourgogne Pinot Noir 2016, Domaine Francois Raquillet, Mercurey, Burgundy, France</b>	<b>47</b>
A Pinot Noir of vibrancy, purity and finesse, with a floral, spicy Pinot nose, sweet raspberry fruit and delicate nuttiness. A well-developed & charming Mercury	
<b>Palazzo Della Torre 2015, Allegrini, Veneto, Italy</b>	<b>48</b>
Enticing aromas of cherry with rich dark chocolate notes. Velvety in texture, it is well-balanced and offers ripe, juicy dark fruit, with silky tannins and refreshing acidity.	
<b>Black Slate 2017, La Conreria d'Scala Dei, Priorat, Spain - Organic</b>	<b>53</b>
60% Garnacha, 35% Carignan and 5% Cab Sauvignon. Each wine is made by a different Bodega to illustrate the different terroirs of each town in the area. Elegant, rich and silky. Hints of chocolate, spice and dark fruit on the palate & impressive length.	
<b>Crozes Hermitage 2016 'Cuvée Albéric Bouvet', Domaine Gilles Robin, Rhone, France</b>	<b>57</b>
Lush, vibrant black and blueberry nose. Sleek and silky, concentrated yet elegant, lively aftertaste with lots of pepper on the finish. Classic Crozes - not too weighty or extracted but stylish and long.	
<b>Cerasuolo di Vittoria 2015, Cos, Vittoria, Sicily Italy</b>	<b>61</b>
Sicilian blend of indigenous Frappato and Nero d'Avola grapes. Aromas of sweet violets and a whisper of spiced cherries. The wine is very smooth, almost silky and the bright berry flavours cascade over the tongue to their lip-smacking conclusion.	
<b>Brunello di Montalcino 2014 Fossacolle, Tuscany, Italy</b>	<b>71</b>
An excellent Brunello vintage with a dense concentration of fruit and an abundance of dried-berry fruit, chocolate and earth aromas & flavours. Great structure & drinking beautifully now but take another home & pop in your cellar!	
<b>Pommard 'Tavannes' 2015, Dom.Fernand &amp; Laurent Pillot, Burgundy, France</b>	<b>75</b>
A mouth-filling, perfume-y Pinot Noir from the village of Tavannes in Pommard. Winning cherry fruit, spice and mineral flavours framed by grippy but reassuringly fine tannins. Great length. One to consider if you're trying to convert a devotee of big reds to the pleasures of Burgundy.	
<b>Barolo 'Albe' 2015, Aldo Vajra, Piedmont, Italy</b>	<b>78</b>
A traditional-style Barolo made from fruit sourced from three different vineyard. Aromas of red fruits and plums, flowers & pine needle. Albe is a harmony of sophisticated and delicate flavours supported by an elegant acidity and ripe tannins.

Deep and dark. A nose of perfectly interwoven aromas of black-berried fruit, pepper and balsamic hints of eucalyptus. Impressive palate with an imposing structure, making it both powerful and refined.	
<b>La Poja 2013, Allegrini, Veneto, Italy</b>	96
Single vineyard Corvina from the Valpolicella region. Majestic, rich, luscious & well bred.	
<b>Barolo Vigneto Rocche 2010, Andrea Oberto, Piedmont</b>	98
A balanced and delicate single vineyard Barolo. Succulent and beautifully defined, seamless finesse.	
<b>Volnay 1er Cru Santenots 2013, Domaine Nicolas Rossignol, Burgundy</b>	98
Deftly composed & strikingly bold 1er Cru; voluptuous & powerful. It will reward with decanting & patience	
<b>Brunello di Montalcino 2014, Fuligni, Tuscany, Italy</b>	110
Lovers of serious Sangiovese need look no further than Fulignis classic Brunello. Elegant rose petal & cherry character with mushroom undertones. Velvety tannins & and a lovely savoury finish. Delicious, solid and harmonious wine
